Zapcat and RIB Day



The "Must Do" Activity

Zapcats have been raced in the UK since 2001 and are now the world's largest one-design offshore powerboat class. Light, incredibly agile, yet very stable tunnel-hulled catamarans have explosive power! "Fast, Fun & Fantastic!"

Versatile

Zapcats are a great activity combination for any Multi-Activity event and can be operated at sea in conjunction with RIBs, Yachts, Powerboats & Luxury or Performance Motorboats. They can be combined for Challenges - such as time trials and RIB treasure hunts or with land based activities near the sea such as Apache or Rage buggies for an all out Adrenaline Day!

Dragon Boating - Dragon Boat racing involves teams of up to twenty paddlers in a 40 foot boat with a drummer and helm, paddling frantically to beat the other teams down the course. The drums, shouting and colourful boats make it an impressive and exciting sport both to watch and to compete in.

The races are a colourful spectacle, with at least two boats competing against each other over distances from 200 to 2000 metres and above. Not only are strength, endurance and skill important but teamwork and harmony of purpose.

Bell Boating - Bell boats are designed like catamarans. They have two hulls, which are joined by a central platform to give them extra stability in the water. Their clever design makes them almost impossible to overturn in calm water. They can usually hold up to ten people plus the 'helm', who steers the boat. All of our staff who take students bell boating are properly qualified and are trained first aiders.

Coast Steering - Spend time traversing rocks, swimming between gaps, playing team games such as the 'washing machine' and the 'angle run', cliff jumping (choose your own comfortable height that suits your nerve) and exploring caves - try not to get washed out to sea!

A great group adventure activity, even suitable for non-swimmers. In South West Wales, the session includes the Blue Lagoon Challenge (3 tiered jumps and the 45 degree slab run). Cliff jumps are optional!

Raft Design, Build & Race Team Challenge - Using wooden poles and planks, Barrels and ropes your team will build a raft capable of getting you around a set course on the lake or even out to sea!

Once you have designed your raft you will then move on to building it using ropes to lash the spars and barrels together. If your lashings are loose and your raft isn't built correctly you're in for a wet session.
